Student Award for Academic Excellence

I am pleased to announce the introduction of a new student award for academic excellence - the Deputy Principal's Award.

Criteria

In 2017/18 the Award will be made to individual students who meet the following criteria:

- **Full time undergraduate students*** studying on campus at any one of our campus locations.
- **Attain 6 Grade A's** with passes at Grade D or higher in the other courses, at the first sitting.
- Students with any reassessments, course failures, or grade Es in the year are automatically disqualified from the award.
- The rules will be adjusted for students with one semester's absence for medical or personal reasons.
